Conditions of participation in the conference

Each participant may submit two papers co-authored with or without co-authors (co-authors are not more than three persons). Distant participation with article publishing in the book of the conference proceedings is also possible. Conference regulations prohibit participation of graduate students, Candidates and Doctors of Science as co-authors since the conference is intended for students only. Supervisor can be specified at the end of the article. All articles will be checked for originality.

All publications are free of charge. ISBN number will be assigned to the book of conference proceedings, all the materials published will be included to RSCI (Russian Science Citation Index).

To participate in the conference you need to fill the application form and send it to the organizing committee by e-mail, as well as deadlines to send an article to be published in the collection of materials.

Certificates of conference are awarded with one of the conditions:

- full-time participation in the work of the section;
- article published in the conference proceedings.

Authors of the best article will be awarded with diplomas of winners.

**Articles layout requirements****Main properties of the document:**

- A4 page (210 x 297 mm), portrait orientation, Times New Roman font, size 14;
- Margin size, mm: left, top, right – 20, bottom – 32;
- Line spacing 1.25 cm, paragraph indention - 1.25;
- Automatic hyphenation is disabled;
- Using (Tab) or (Space) buttons for paragraph indenting or text alignment is not allowed;

**Article layout scheme:**

1. In the very top line, with *left* alignment, UDC number is placed (common font, size 14).
2. Blank line.
3. List of authors: center alignment, names are written as initials and put in front of the surname, dots after initials are a must, initials are separated from each other and from the surname by the “Space” button. Co-authors of the article are separated with commas.
4. Blank line.
5. Name of the article (center alignment, CAPITAL LETTERS, semi-bold, 14).
6. Blank line.
7. Annotation in English (*italics*, justified alignment, 12).
8. Key words in English (*italics*, justified alignment, 12).
9. Blank line.
10. Text of the article.

**Notes:**

Latin letters are typed in *italics*, Greek and Russian letters – upright type;

Texts in tables, names of the picture and of the tables are typed in Times New Roman font, size 14;

Picture legend texts are typed in Times New Roman font, size 12;

Drawings, created in Word, should be inserted as objects;

Literature references in the text of the article are put in square brackets, bibliography is titled;

Bibliography should consist of no more than 10 positions, bibliographic descriptions of the literary sources are arranged according to GOST (Russian State Standard) 7.1-2003.

Number of co-authors should not exceed three persons. Recommended volume of the article is 4-6 pages. Pictures, charts and tables should be included into this volume.

Authors should avoid repetition of the same data in tables, charts and the main text.

Papers, not arranged in accordance with the above mentioned requirements will not be published or returned.

The organizing committee reserves the right to make literary editing of the article content without authors' agreement.

While writing and submitting papers the authors should observe the set key dates and article layout requirements.

The key dates are set on the basis of technical facilities of the organizing committee.

Organizing committee reserves the right to reject the presented papers due to deadlines violation or non-compliance with the article layout requirements.
